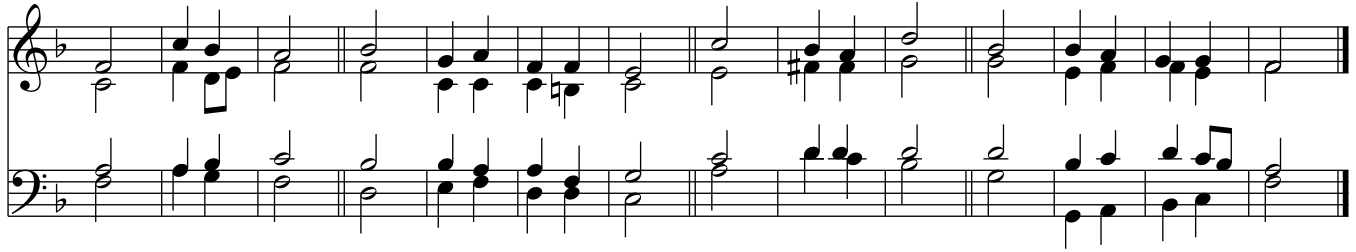


Psalm 1 — *Beatus vir qui non abiit*
