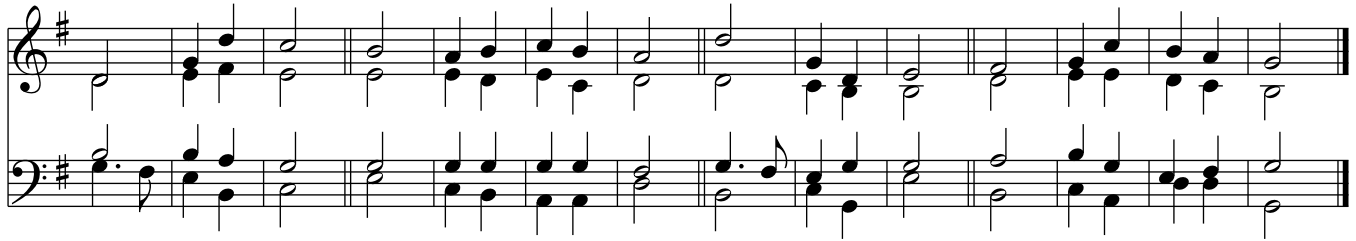


**Psalm 104** — *Benedic, anima mea*
