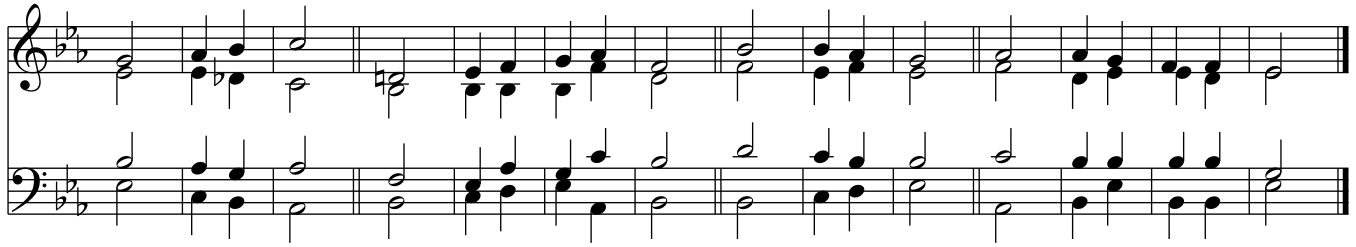


**Psalm 105, Part I — *Confitemini Domino***
