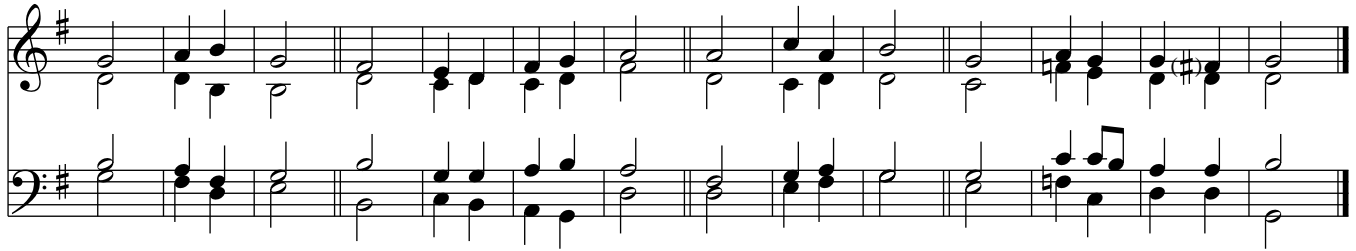


Psalm 107, Part I — *Confitemini Domino*

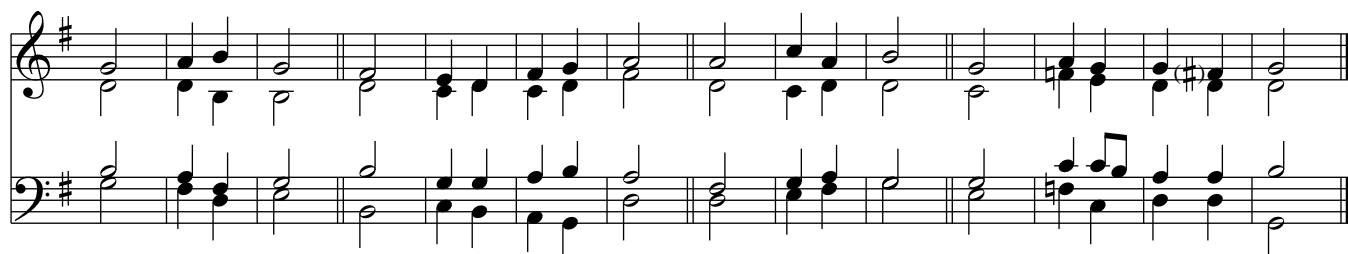
