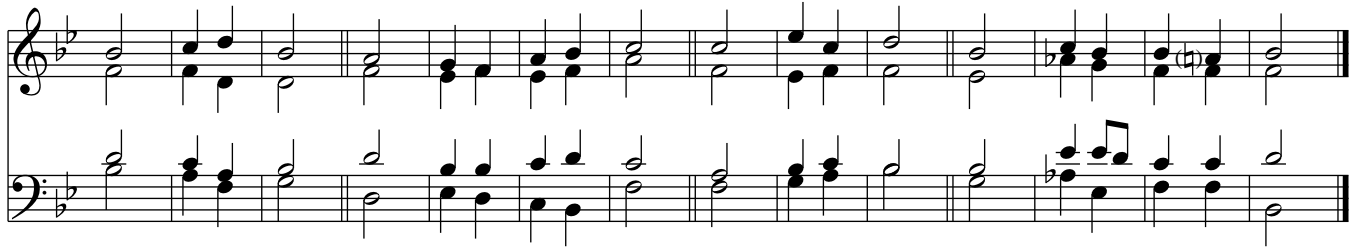


Psalm 107 — *Confitemini Domino*

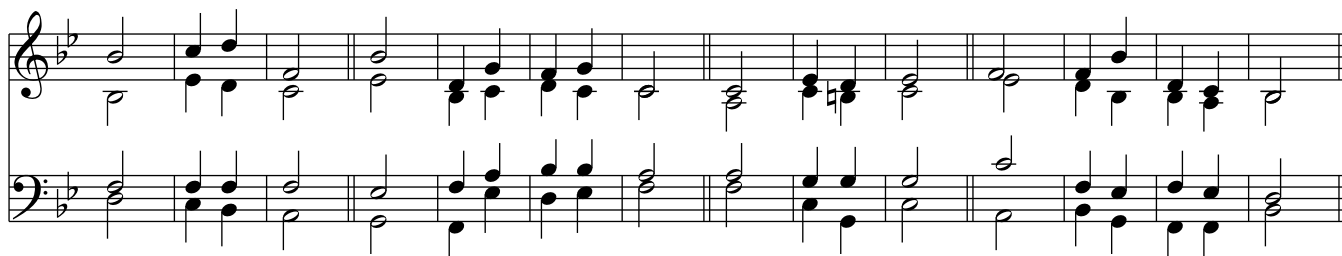
