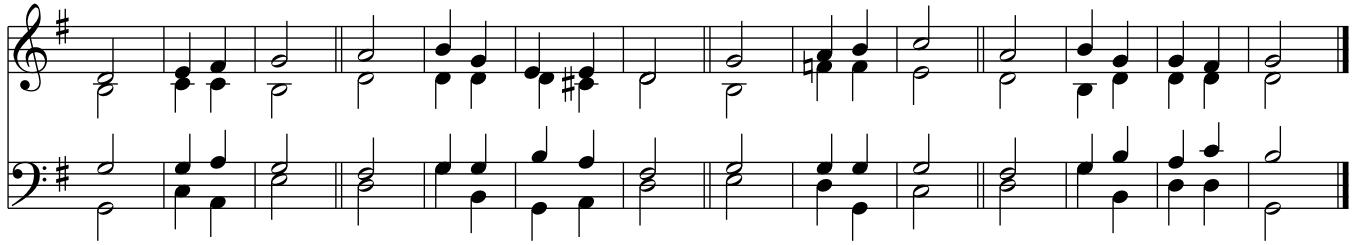


**Psalm 112** — *Beatus vir*
