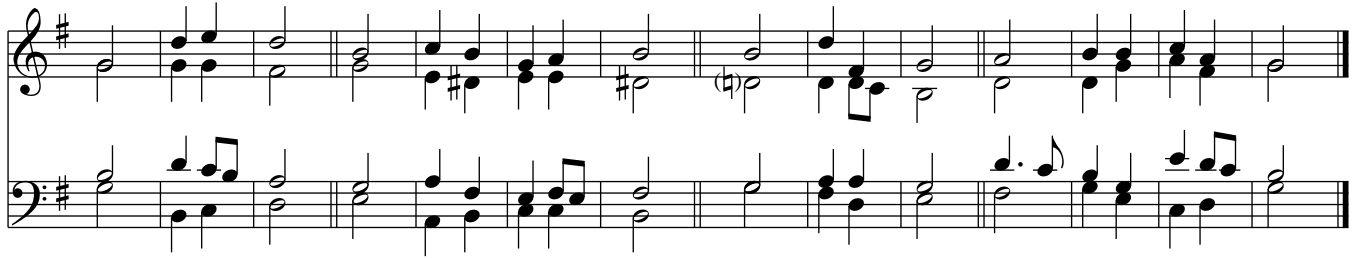


Psalm 114 — *In exitu Israel*
