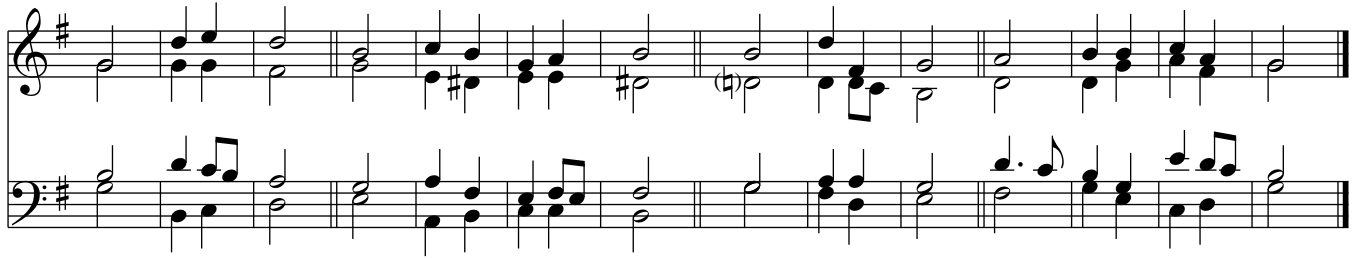


- U* 1 O give thanks unto the LORD, for / he is / gracious;
