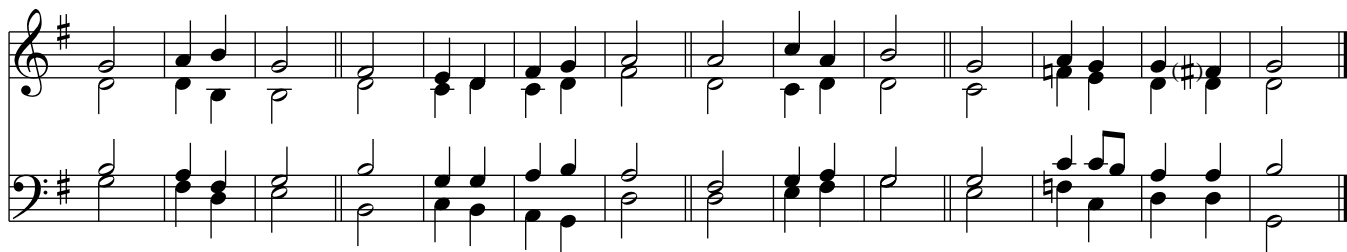


**Psalm 119: Mem — *Quomodo dilexi!***
