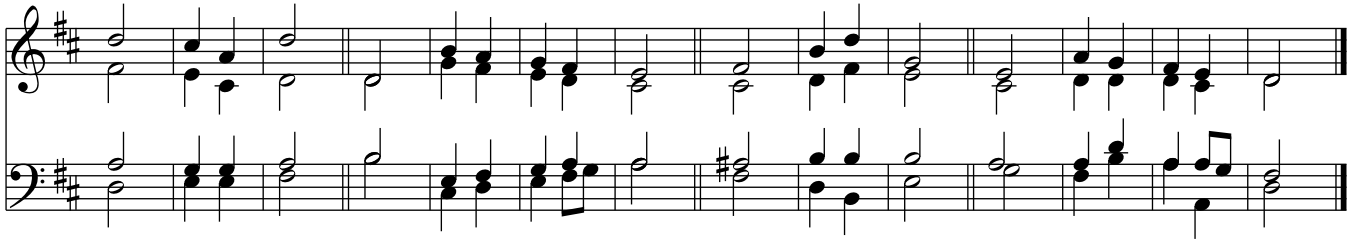


**Psalm 119: Pe** — *Mirabilia*
