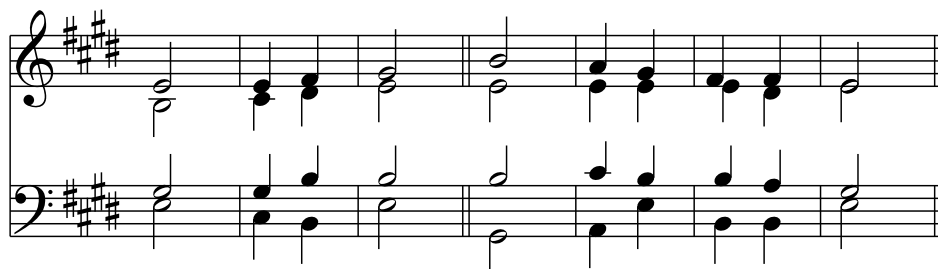


**Psalm 125** — *Qui confidunt*
