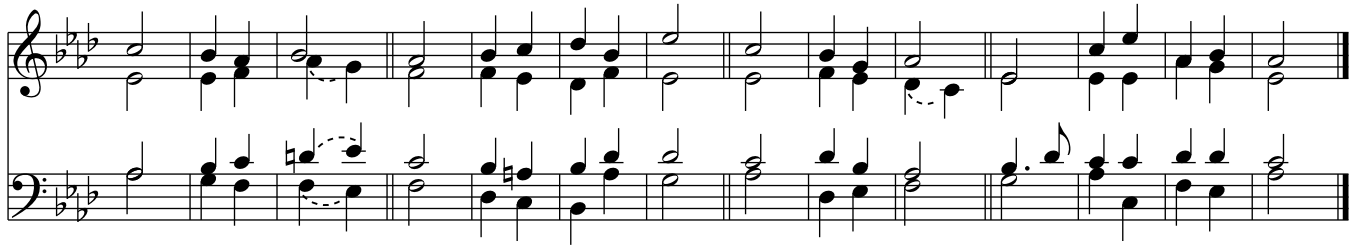


Psalm 126 — *In convertendo*
