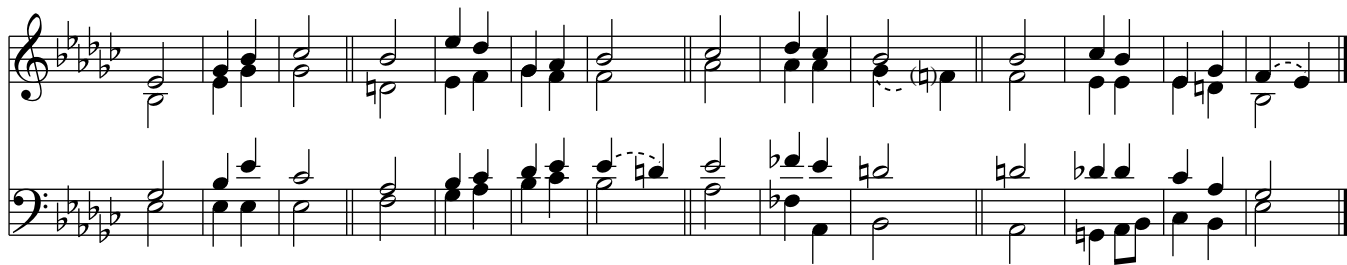


Psalm 130 — *De profundis*
