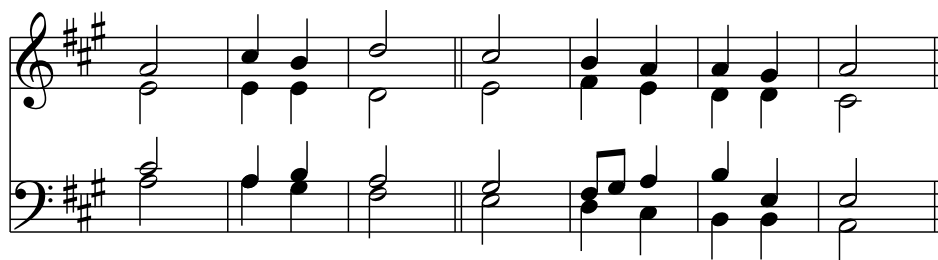


Psalm 131 — *Domine, non est*
