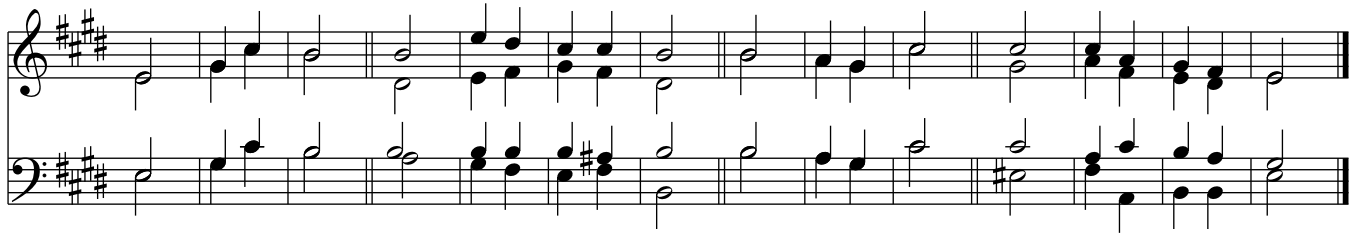


- U* 1 I will magnify thee, O / God, my / King;
