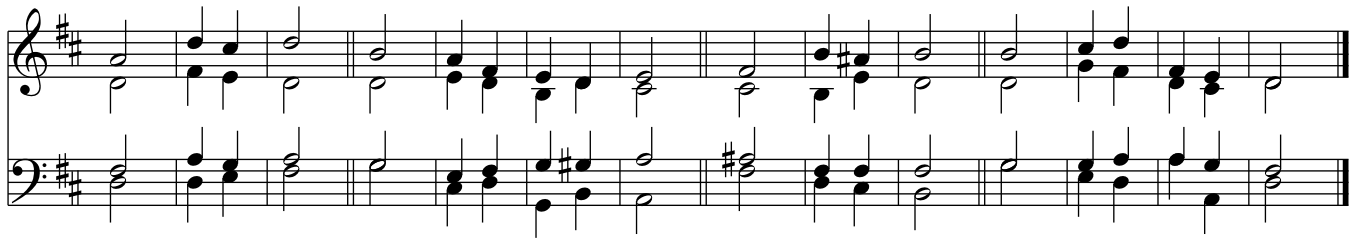


Psalm 147 — *Laudate Dominum*
