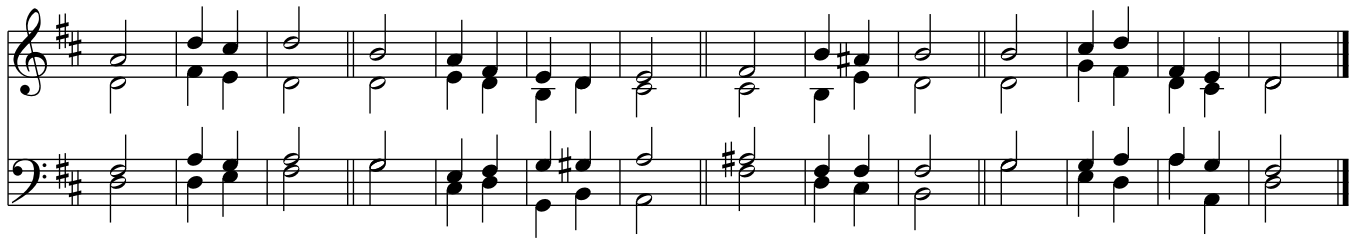


Psalm 147 — *Laudate Dominum*

2 The LORD re- / builds Je- / rusalem;

 and / binds / up their / wounds.

14 For he has strengthened the / bars of your / gates;
 he has / blessed your / children with- / in you.

M 15 He has established / peace on your / borders;
 he satisfies you / with the / fin-est / wheat.
