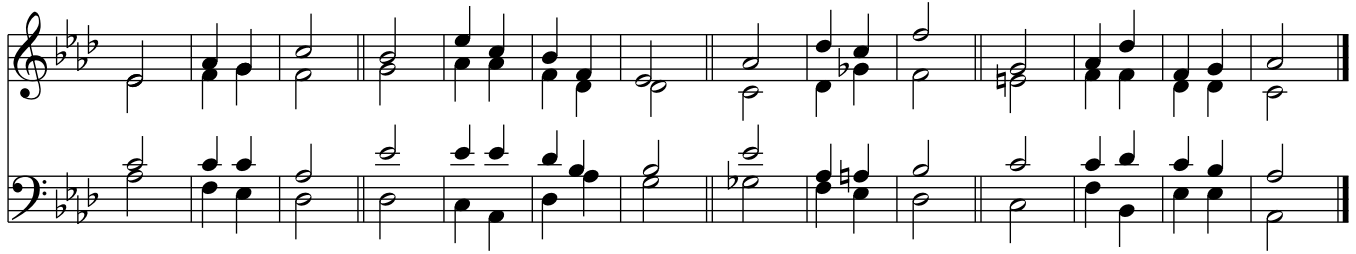


**Psalm 148** — *Laudate Dominum*
