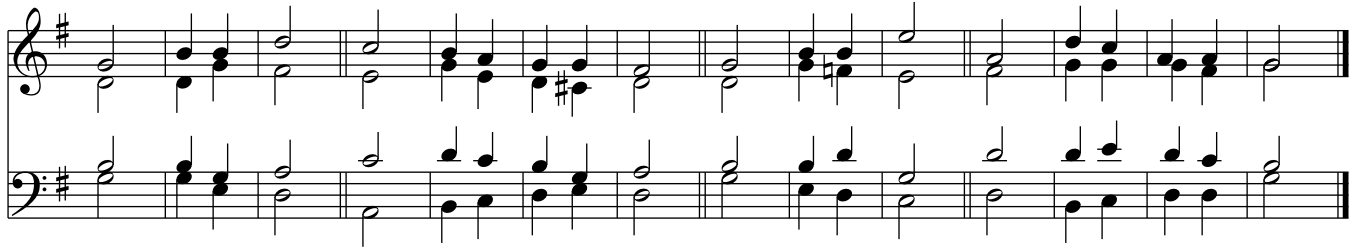


**Psalm 16** — *Conserva me, Domine*
