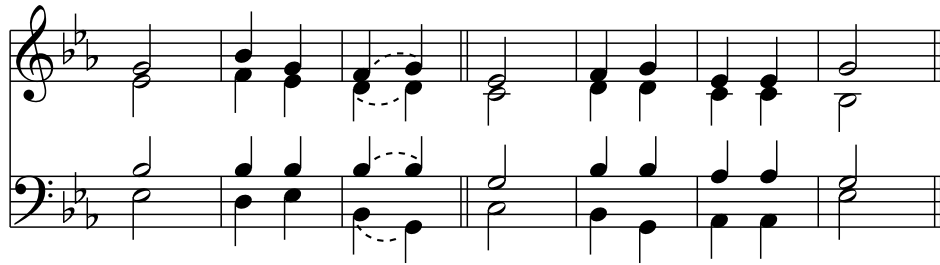


Psalm 23 — *Dominus regit me*
