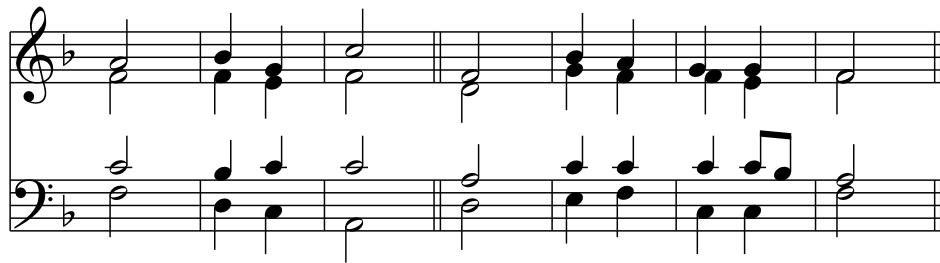


**Psalm 25** — *Ad te, Domine, levavi*
