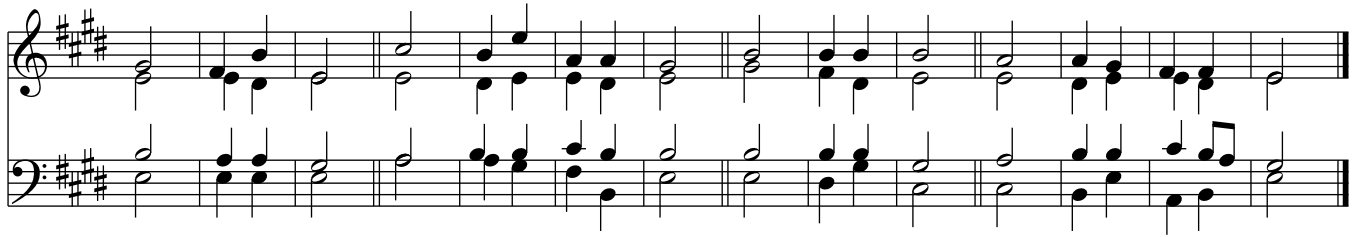


Psalm 26 — *Judica me, Domine*
