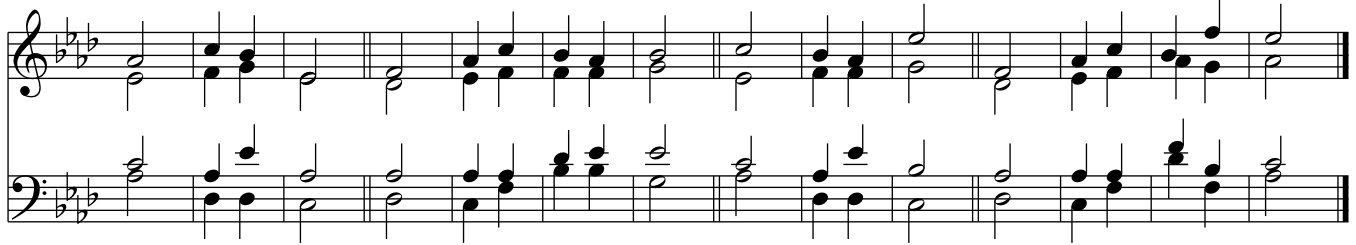


- 4 *f* 1 I will bless the / LORD at all / times;
