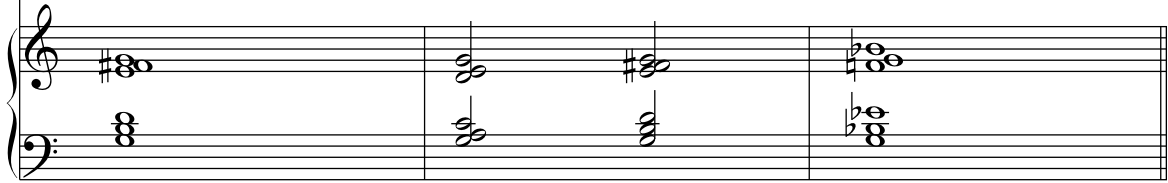

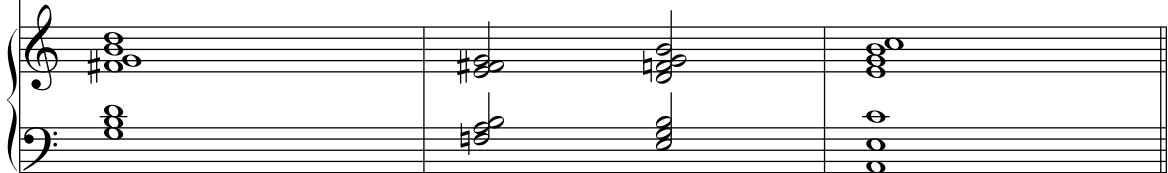

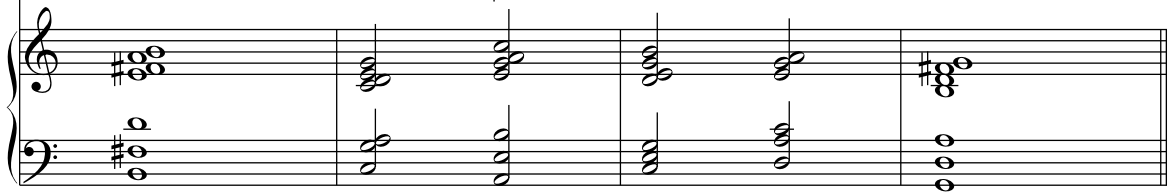
Piano accompaniment for the second system of Psalm 34, measures 4-6. The music continues with the same harmonic accompaniment and bass line.

Piano accompaniment for the fourth system of Psalm 34, measures 10-12. The music concludes with a final chord in G major.

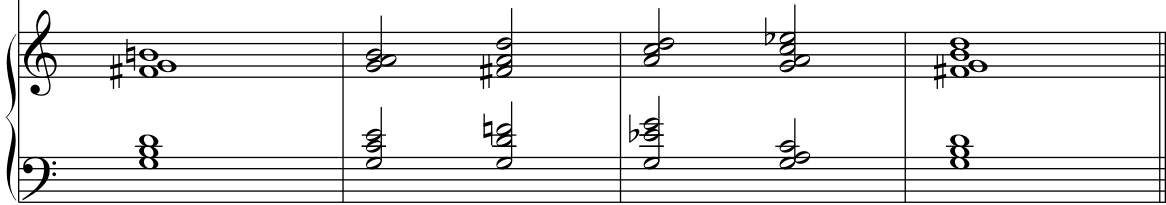

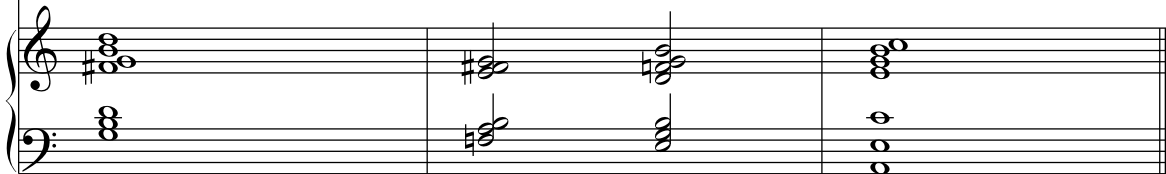

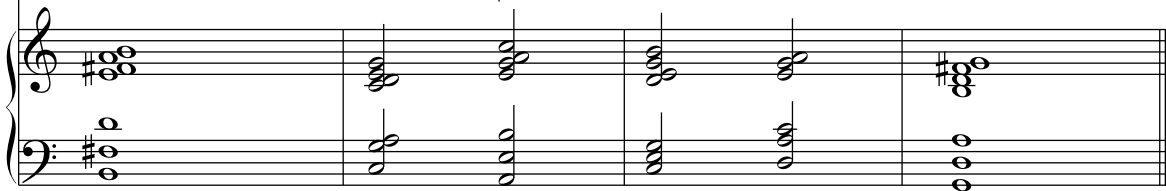
