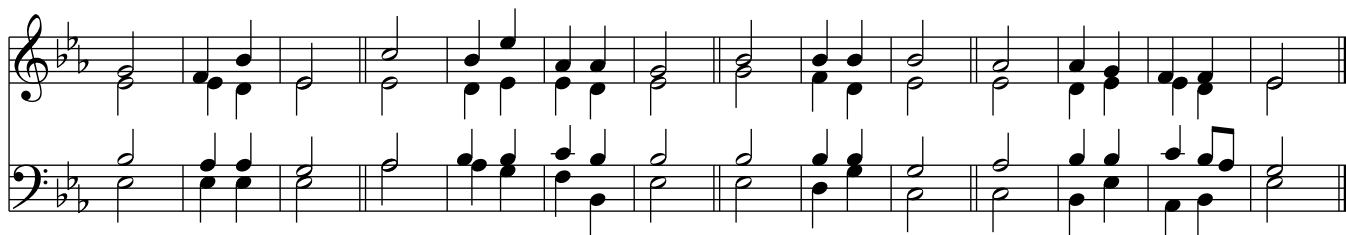




- 4 1 Do not fret yourself because of / e-vil- / doers;
