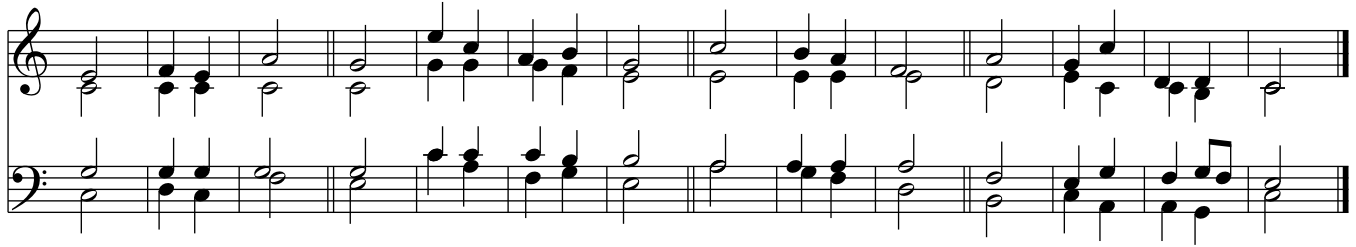


Psalm 4 — *Cum invocarem*
