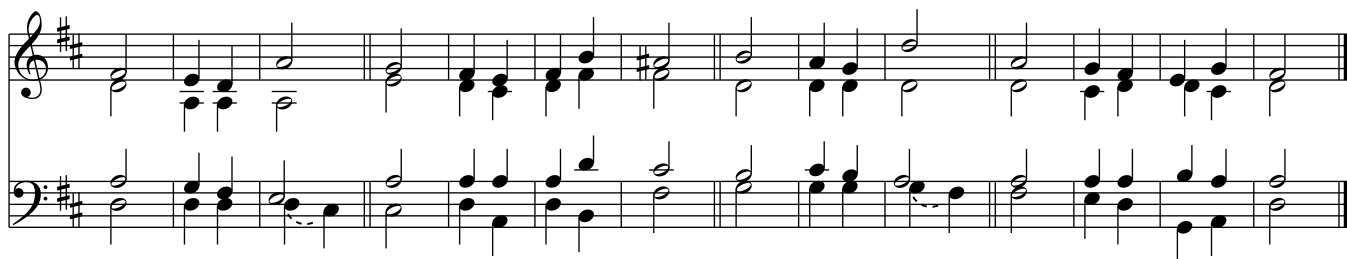




- U 1 For God alone my soul in / si-lence / waits;
