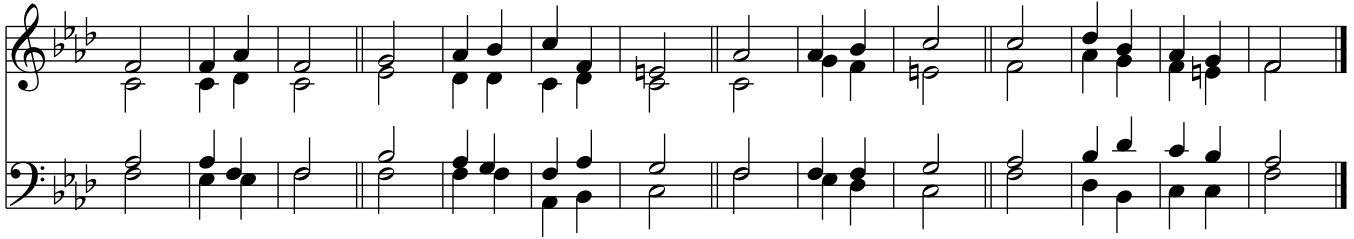


Psalm 91 — *Qui habitat*
