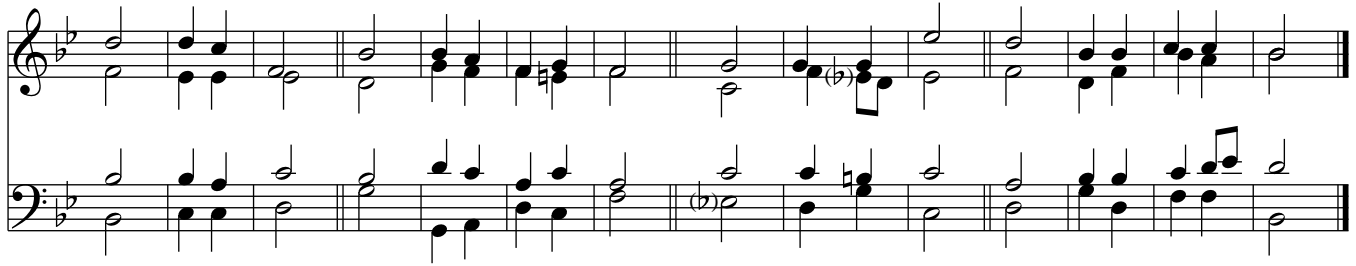


Psalm 96 — *Cantate Domino*
