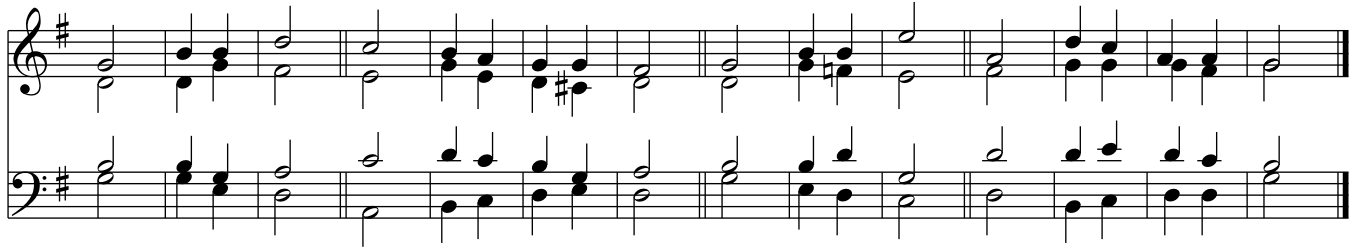


Psalm 98 — *Cantate Domino*
